Dear dispenser

Thank you for informing the Council that you do not wish to be registered.

It is possible to voluntarily suspend your registration; however, the Code of Practice includes time limits on Voluntary Suspension. Anyone who is voluntarily suspended from the register for a period of three years or more will be required to undertake examinations before re-entry will be granted. The Council's requirements in relations to Continuous Professional Development apply only to those on the register at any given time.

As you may be aware, the Government has announced its intention to abolish the Council and transfer its regulatory functions to other bodies. It is not possible at this stage to advise you of any requirements for re-registration for these subsequent bodies.

Please complete and return the enclosed statutory declaration set out in clause 11(b) of the Registration Rules. **This must be signed in the presence of a solicitor or Notary Public.**

I look forward to receiving the signed and witness declaration in the near future.
